GUARANTEE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Guarantee

Leather: Your **Black Country Saddle** is warranted against faulty workmanship and materials, subject to fair wear and tear, for a period of one year. Some colour loss may be normal and should not be considered a defect.

Tree: Your **Black Country Saddle** has been made using a tree made in our own Tree Shop which conforms to the latest British Standard BS6635. The tree is guaranteed against **general riding conditions only** for a period of 10 years.

- •Unauthorized repairs and alterations to this saddle will invalidate the warranty
- •This guarantee is non transferable, any complaints should be directed through the original vendor.
- •This does not affect your statutory rights.

Care Instructions:

Remember leather is a natural product and with the right care grows ever more beautiful with age. Some small scars may be apparent and enhance the natural finish, they should not be considered as a defect.

We recommend our *Black Country Saddles Premium Saddle Soap* for cleaning and breaking in your new saddle, it may *initially* be necessary to use a neatsfoot oil on any reverse side of leather to enhance its suppleness. *Do Not* use oil to excess as this will saturate and can cause leather to weaken, stretch and rot stitching.

On a regular basis, wipe away any excess dirt and grease with a damp cloth and then clean with the soap to soften your saddle. If required to prevent drying out, we recommend our *Black Country Saddles Premium Leathercare Balsam*.

NB: The Vintage, Buffalo, Doe and Calf leathers require special treatment, please consult your stockist for further information.

Important

- •If your saddle gets wet, allow to dry naturally. Do Not subject to direct heat or sunshine.
- Do Not store in extreme temperatures.
- •Regularly check your saddle for condition, wear and tear
- •We suggest that it is good stable management to monitor the fit or your saddle and check for any signs of discomfort in your horse.
- •Please use the saddle only on the horse to which is was fitted, as using it on another horse can considerably alter the shape and could lead to problems.
- •Avoid riding in jeans with inside leg seams.
